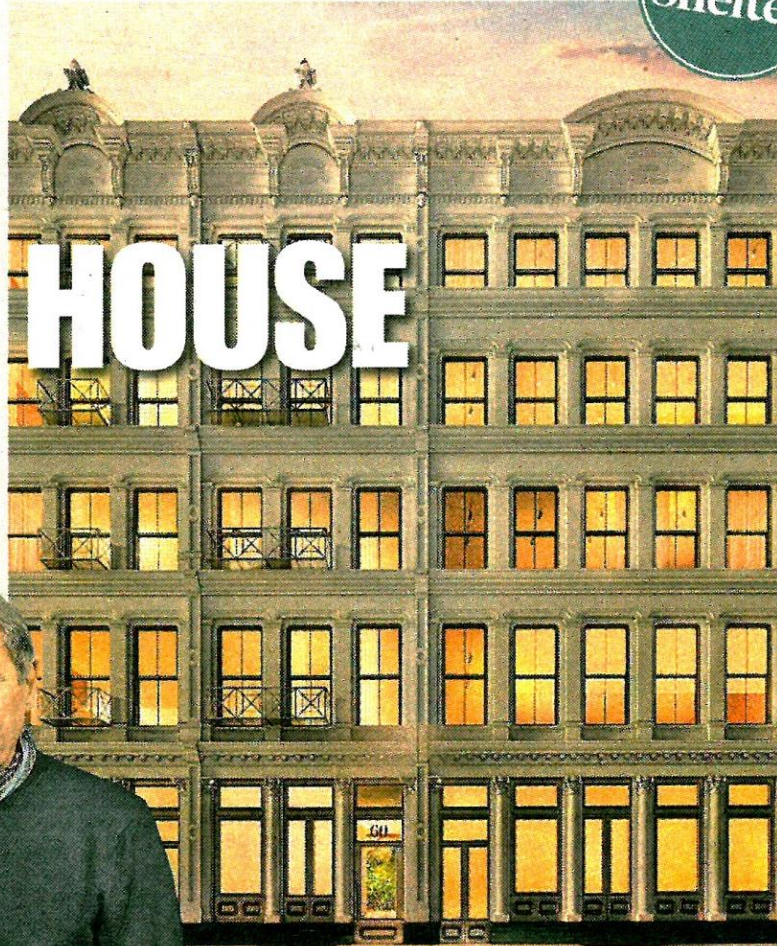
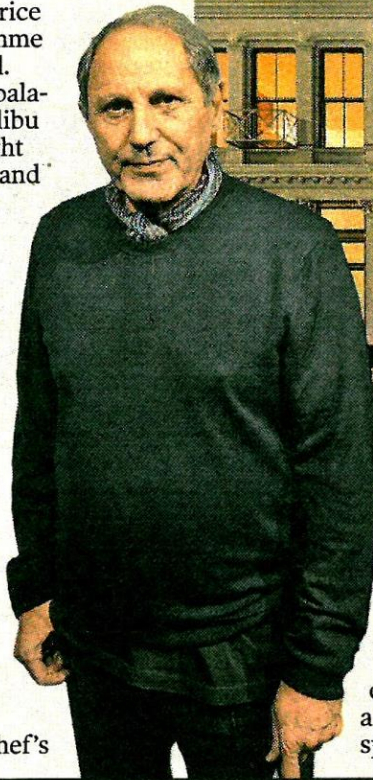

## MOVING INTO THE WHITE HOUSE

FASHION mogul **Serge Azria**, the creative force/CEO behind Joie, Equipment and Current/Elliott, is in contract to buy an eco-chic penthouse at 60 White St. for its full asking price of \$9.4 million, Gimme Shelter has learned. Azria also owns a palatial \$41 million Malibu estate that he bought from "Karate Kid" and "Ocean's Eleven" producer Jerry Weintraub. Azria, born in Tunisia, is the brother of **Max Azria**, whose massive BCBG Max Azria fashion empire houses 20 global brands. Eighty percent of the 3,129-square-foot, three-bedroom, four-bathroom unit was made reclaimed materials, including solid oak wood. Details include a chef's
