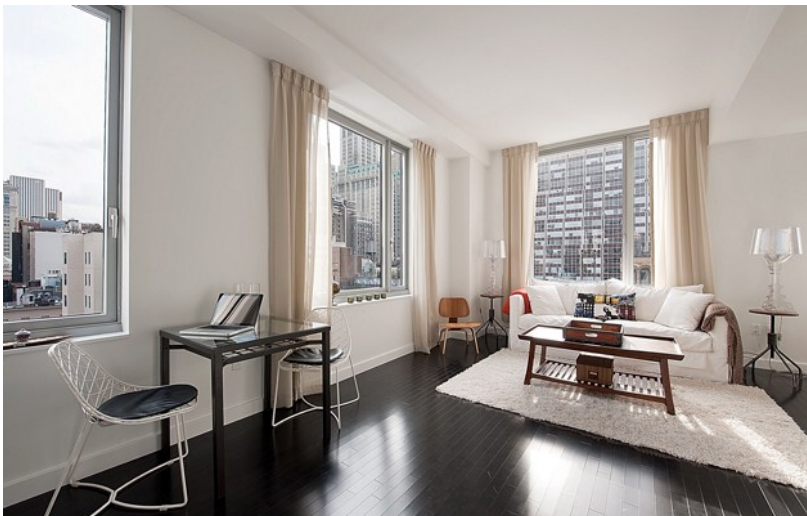
## Rangers players scope out apartments in Tribeca
