New York City is known for its amazing and iconic architecture. With an asking price of \$3.6 million, the pre-war Penthouse designed by [Messana O'Rorke Architects](#) has two bedrooms and one and a half baths, along with incredible features like 12-foot ceilings, oversized windows, a fireplace and a landscaped terrace.

And as if those luxuries weren't enough, here comes the jaw-dropping feature: if you take the stainless steel staircase from the dining area up to the roof terrace, you will find that these innovative architects converted a massive industrial water tank into a truly unique one room cottage with soaring ceilings and modern amenities.

According to [Douglas Elliman](#) real estate agency, the separate living area, complete with central air, heat, cable, oculus and 24-foot ceilings, is the only one of its kind in New York City -- pretty cool, huh?
