### Special interest in ICSC Las Vegas expo this year

In an innovative new session to be held at the International Council of Shopping Centers Inc.'s annual RECon convention in Las Vegas, some of the industry's most senior and influential female professionals will lead a Special Interest Group of roundtables geared toward Women In Retail Real Estate.

"Women in Retail Real Estate" will take place from 10:45 a.m. to 12 noon on Sunday, May 23, the first day of RECon 2010, which will run until May 25. Special Interest Groups (SIGs) focus on a specific discipline of the industry and allow industry professionals to meet to share common ideas, interest and challenges.

These group meetings will allow for informal interactive discussions. Women in Retail Real Estate is one of 10 SIGs that will be held simultaneously; others include Architect/Design, Construction and Alliance/Public Sector.
